### East Anglia ONE North Offshore Windfarm Order 2022 (“the Order”) - Variation 1 (Schedules 13 and 14)

In April 2022 the Secretary of State for the Department for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy (BEIS) granted consent for the East Anglia (EA) ONE North Offshore Wind Farm Order 2022 (“the Order”) which included, in Schedules 13 and 14, Deemed Marine Licences (DMLs) in accordance with Section 149 of the Planning Act 2008.

In October 2025 the Marine Management Organisation (MMO) received a request from the Project to vary the DMLs for EA ONE North (Schedules 13 and 14) contained within the Order. The request was to make the following change:

1. To include the designated disposal site references TH083 and HU212 in the Generation Asset DML (Schedule 13) and references TH082 and TH087 in the Transmission Asset DML (Schedule 14).

The MMO has now completed its consideration of these requests and, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 72(3)(d) of the Marine and Coastal Access Act 2009, has varied the DMLs as detailed in the Notices of Variation enclosed.

Also enclosed is a copy of the varied DMLs.

In accordance with regulation 3 of The Marine Licensing (Notices Appeals) Regulations 2011, you may appeal the notice of variation to the First-tier Tribunal. If you wish to appeal then in accordance with Rule 22(1)(b) of the Tribunal Procedure (First-tier Tribunal) (General Regulatory Chamber) Rules 2009 (SI 2009/1976) you have 28 days from the date of the sending of the notice of variation to send or deliver a notice of appeal to the First-tier Tribunal.
