My Objection is based on the following .

The proposed development would result in the loss of privacy, possible increased noise, and the overshadowing to neighbouring properties.

The overdevelopment and scale /or density of the proposed development would be out of character and not in keeping with the surrounding area.

This building is at the back of the owner's house that is also used as a HMO, and this would also be the case for the proposed building.
