JUDGMENT

1. The Claimant did not attend and was not represented at a Case Management Preliminary Hearing held on 13 January 2026.
2. Having heard submissions from Counsel for the Respondent, Ms A Greenley, and having made such enquiries as were practicable about the reasons for the Claimant's absence, pursuant to rule 47 of The Employment Tribunal Procedure Rules 2024, the Claim is dismissed.
3. The Hearing scheduled for 8 days commencing on 18 May 2026 is cancelled.
4. The deposit of £400 paid on 2 June 2025 following the Orders of Employment Judge Wedderspoon dated 22 April 2025 must be refunded to the Claimant.
