# Report on the use of closed material procedure

From 25 June 2023 to 24 June 2024

Section 12(1) of the Justice and Security Act 2013 (“the Act”) requires the Secretary of State to prepare (and lay before Parliament) a report on the use of the closed material procedure (CMP) under section 6 of the Act. Under section 12(4) of the Act, the report must be prepared and laid before Parliament as soon as reasonably practicable after the end of the twelve-month period to which the report relates.

The report is submitted in the form of a series of tables: “Applications”, “Declarations”, “Revocations”, “Final Judgments” list numbers, as prescribed by section 12(2) of the Act.

The table titled “Additional Information” is provided in response to recommendation 1 of Sir Duncan Ouseley’s 2022 independent report on the operation of CMP under the Justice and Security Act 2013 (the Ouseley Report).<sup>1</sup> This table provides case detail on open CMP cases under the Act during the reporting period. This information is provided at the discretion of the Secretary of State under section 12(3) of the Act.

The Ouseley Report also sought for this publication to comment on the availability of DV-cleared staff in the court system to support CMP cases. HM Courts and Tribunals Service (HMCTS) and Northern Ireland Courts and Tribunals Service (NICTS) confirm that the level of DV-cleared court staff has increased since the Ouseley Report was published in 2022, and they are sufficiently resourced to meet current demands within Court Operations.

This is the eleventh annual report on this subject and covers the period from 25 June 2023 to 24 June 2024.

The information contained within this report is provided to the best of the case holders’ ability.
