

**RA 2335 Form 6: Display Parachuting Public Display Authority (PDA) Form**

1. An RA 2335 Form 6, and its associated annexes, **should** be completed by Aviation Duty Holder (ADH) / Accountable Manager (Military Flying) (AM(MF)) for military personnel that will conduct Display Parachuting.
2. In accordance with (iaw) RA 2335 – Flying Displays, Display Flying, Display Parachuting, Role Demonstrations and Flypasts, paragraph 139 the completed PDA Form 6, along with its associated annexes, **should** be sent to the Military Aviation Authority (MAA) via email: [DSA-MAA-Display-Forms@mod.gov.uk](mailto:DSA-MAA-Display-Forms@mod.gov.uk). A copy of the PDA **should** be carried by the team leader / Drop Zone Safety Officer and made available to Head of Establishment, Flying Display Directors (FDD) or Event Organizers.
3. The personnel detailed in the table below are authorized to conduct the public Display Parachuting Sequence detailed in Annex A and B to this document, iaw RA 2335:

1. Duty Holder (DH) / ADH **should** provide a signed PDF document that includes the following minimum detail:

- a. **The Occasion for the PDA.** This can be for a single occasion, a specific period or for an entire Display Season.
- b. **Display Team Name.** Details of the Display Team Name.
- c. **Display Sequence Names and Descriptions.** This section **should** include details of all Display Sequences approved ie or a list of approved manoeuvres. A ribbon diagram for each Display Sequence **should** be provided at Annex B if applicable.
- d. **Display Duration.** The Display duration **should** be provided for each approved Display Sequence. This **should** include any time required to assess meteorological conditions and allow for drop Aircraft positioning.
- e. **Display Sequence Minimum Drop Heights.** The drop minimum heights and minimum opening / under developed canopy heights **should** be provided, in height above ground level (AGL), for each approved display.
- f. **Weather Minima.** Details of the weather minima, including cloud base and visibility, and wind speed **should** be provided for each approved Display Sequence.
- g. **Permitted Modifications to Display Sequences and Approved Basic Manoeuvres.** The details of any permitted Display Sequence Modifications **should** be included. This section can be omitted if it is not applicable.
- h. **Civil Aviation Authority (CAA) Article 90.** Include details on how the team are managing UK CAA [Article 90](#) permissions when jumping from civil registered aircraft.
- i. **Contact Details.** Contact details of key display team members **should** be provided.
