Judgment

1. The claim for unlawful deduction of wages is well-founded. This means that the respondent has made an unlawful deduction from the claimant's wages and is ordered to pay to the claimant the gross sum of £10,728.99, in respect of the amount unlawfully deducted.

2. The Respondent was in breach of contract for not reimbursing the Claimant her petrol expenses. The Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant £150 in damages for breach of contract.
