## RULE 22 JUDGMENT

1. The respondent did not present a response to the claim. The claimant provided information in the claim form and by correspondence to the Tribunal, upon which a determination could properly be made of the claims pursuant to rule 22 of the Employment Tribunal Rules 2024.
2. The claim for unauthorised deductions from wages (Employment Rights Act 1996 section 13) is well founded.
3. The respondent must pay to the claimant the following gross sums within 14 days:
  - a. One week's unpaid wages: £1469<sup>1</sup> gross
  - b. Accrued but untaken holiday pay: £349.26<sup>2</sup> gross
