Freedom of Information: Late Payment Details

Thank you for your email of 24th June to the Trade Remedies Authority (TRA) in which you requested the following:

Information in respect of suppliers which were not paid within 30 days for the period starting 1 April 2019 to the date of this request:

1. Supplier Name
2. Invoice Date
3. Gross Invoice Value
4. Payment Date
5. Late Payment Compensation or Interest Paid (if any)

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 ('the Act'), you have the right to:

- know whether we hold the information you require
- be provided with that information (subject to any exemptions under the Act which may apply).

By way of background, the Trade Remedies Authority (TRA) was established on 1 June 2021 as an arm's length body of the Department for Business and Trade (DBT). Up until March 2024, UK Shared Business Services (UKSBS) was responsible for the administration of centralised billing and invoice payments for DBT, of which TRA was on the same ledger. In April 2024, the TRA moved to its own ledger, with UKSBS continuing to process payments on its behalf.

Data for the period June 2021 to March 2023 has been published on the TRA website in response to a previous freedom of information request. This can be found at [Transparency and freedom of information releases - GOV.UK](#) and therefore section 21 is

being applied (information reasonably accessible). Data for the period April 2023 to the date of your request is provided in the attached spreadsheet.

I can confirm that no late payment compensation or interest payments have been made, or were requested.

Appeals procedure

If you are dissatisfied with the handling of your request, you have the right to ask for an internal review. Internal review requests should be submitted within two months of the date of receipt of the response to your original request and should be addressed to Knowledge and Information Management:
