## JUDGMENT

1. The claimant's complaint of unauthorised deductions from wages is well-founded. The respondent made unauthorised deductions from the claimant's wages in the period 8<sup>th</sup> August 2023 to 11<sup>th</sup> July 2024.
2. The respondent shall pay the claimant **£3,605.16**, which is the gross sum deducted. The respondent is responsible for the payment of any tax or National Insurance.
3. The respondent failed to give the claimant written itemised pay statements as required by section 8 Employment Rights Act 1996 for the period April 2024 to July 2024 inclusive.
