

DECLARATION OF SPECIAL MEASURES: HUNGARY (REVOCATION)

THE TRADE IN ANIMALS AND RELATED PRODUCTS (WALES) REGULATIONS 2011 (SI 2011/2379 (W. 252))

The Welsh Ministers are satisfied that the grounds to suspect the existence of peste des petits ruminants in Hungary no longer exist, and that the restrictions on certain products originating from Hungary are no longer required.

In exercise of the powers conferred by regulation 29(3) of the Trade in Animals and Related Products (Wales) Regulations 2011¹, the Welsh Ministers revoke the following special measures in Wales.

Revocation

1. The “Declaration of Special Measures: Hungary” made by the Welsh Ministers on 31 January 2025 is revoked.

Coming into force of the Declaration

2. This Declaration comes into force on the day following the day on which the Declaration is made.
