IV. Health Information

I, the undersigned, an authorised Official Veterinarian, certify that the bird(s) described above meet the following requirements:

1. EITHER

a. The birds are derived from the United Kingdom, or a region (zone)*** of the United Kingdom*, where highly pathogenic avian influenza (as defined in the WOHAT Terrestrial Code) was not recorded for the following period (and no case of High Pathogenic Avian Influenza has been detected within a radius of 10km around the exporting premises):

Either

*i. for at least 12 months prior to export in accordance the published animal health reports;

Or

*ii. for at least 28 days prior to export following application of a stamping-out policy, and surveillance has been carried out;

OR

*b. i. The birds have been placed under veterinary supervision in isolation from other birds for at least 21 days prior to export and have shown no signs of any compulsory notifiable bird disease;

and

ii. The birds have been tested for Avian Influenza after 14 days of isolation with negative results.

2. The birds are derived from a region (zone)*** which is free from Newcastle disease for the following period:

EITHER

*a. for at least 3 months in case of applying a stamping-out policy;

OR

*b. for at least 12 months if the stamping-out policy is not applied;

3. The birds are derived from establishment(s) free from other compulsory notifiable bird diseases for at least 3 months or tests to ensure that they are free of these diseases that have been recorded in the 3 months prior to shipment;

4. The birds have been clinically examined during (48) hours before export and there was no signs of highly pathogenic avian influenza and other bird diseases;

5. Record of the vaccinations which were given to the birds within the six months prior to export;

6. The birds have been resident in the United Kingdom either since hatching or at least the 3 months preceding export to UAE (except UAE resident birds re-entering UAE after visit to UK);
