Summary

This Regulatory Notice informs the regulated community of the Defence Maritime Regulators issuance of a published view of the Regulation Source Record (RSR).

Background

The Defence Maritime Regulator (DMR) has undertaken a comprehensive review to identify all provenance sources applicable to each regulation, thereby ensuring that all relevant legislation remains current and accurately reflected within the regulatory framework. The RSR consolidates all legislation associated with the DSA02-DMR regulations and is maintained as a living document, updated in line with legislative amendments as they occur.

Intent

The intent of this publication is to enable the regulated community to determine, with clarity and assurance, the full suite of legislation that may be applicable to their activities. This document is reviewed and kept up to date by the R&C team as and when legislative changes occur.

Guidance

The following guidance outlines how to derive maximum utility from the published version of the RSR.



- Access the RSR each time information is required to ensure that the most up-to-date data is made available.
- Open the RSR using the Excel desktop application to ensure full functionality.
- Utilise the filter and un-filter functions within Excel to locate the required information efficiently. Remove the filter from the same column to restore full visibility of the data.
- Owing to limitations within Excel, the full content of Column J may not always be visible; where necessary, copy and paste the text into a Word document to view the complete entry or the full legislation can be found on [Legislation.gov.uk](https://www.legislation.gov.uk)
