## JUDGMENT

The judgment of the Tribunal is as follows:

### Direct discrimination

1. The complaint of direct age discrimination is not well-founded and is dismissed.

### Harassment

2. The complaint of harassment related to age arising from comments made by the pharmacist on 3 November 2024 is well-founded and succeeds.
3. The remaining complaints of harassment related to age are not well-founded and are dismissed.

### Remedy

4. The respondent shall pay the claimant the sum of **£2,000** as agreed compensation.
