**II. Health Information**

**I, the undersigned official veterinarian, certify that:**

1. The products come from a country or zone which is free from Foot and Mouth Disease (FMD).
2. The country of origin has been recognised by the World Organisation for Animal Health (WOAH) as having a negligible risk for Bovine Spongiform Encephalopathy (BSE) in accordance with the BSE chapter of the WOAH Terrestrial Animal Health Code.
3. The products come from establishment/s officially approved by the veterinary authority of the country of origin.
4. The establishment/s do not process rendered product for feed originating from porcine carcasses or carcasses of dead and/or wild animals.
5. The products have been rendered in an establishment approved by the Minister of Agriculture of Indonesia and are audited regularly by the UK competent authority for compliance with requirements for import into Indonesia.
6. The products have been rendered in establishment/s that either<sup>(3)</sup>:
  - a. render only one species, or;
  - b.
    - i. have dedicated lines for ruminant species and;
    - ii. have traceability of the animals through a reliable system and;
    - iii. keep records of the animal species used for the production and note the date of production on every consignment and;
    - iv. implement a quality and feed safety assurance system following Good Manufacturing Practices and Good Handling Practices.
7. The products have been subjected to heat treatment which achieves thermal destruction of Bacillus anthracis and Clostridium perfringens.
8. After the treatment, necessary precaution has been taken to prevent contamination with potential sources of pathogens.
9. The products must be subjected to routine post-production testing to demonstrate the absence of Salmonella and Clostridium. Those tests have been done at the following accredited laboratory, including the date and result of the test:
  
10. The products must be treated and processed based on the Government Regulations/Standards of the exporting country to ensure the safety of the products.

11. The rendered material has been subjected to either<sup>(3)</sup>:

- a. Batch or Continuous dry heat at a minimum temperature of 100-120 °C (212-248 °F) for a minimum of 40-60 minutes or;
- b. Batch or Continuous wet rendering at a minimum temperature of 90-100 °C (194-212 °F) for a minimum of 30 minutes or;
- c. using an alternative method that has been approved by the competent authority of the exporting country.
