II. Health Information

I, the undersigned official veterinarian, certify that:

1. The products either;
 - a. come from a country, part of the country, or compartments that are free from Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza, or;
 - b. have been processed based on a standard that can deactivate the virus;
2. The products have been rendered in a rendering establishment approved by the Minister of Agriculture of Indonesia and are audited regularly by the UK competent authority for compliance with requirements for import into Indonesia.
3. The products have been rendered in a rendering establishment that:
 - a. i. renders only one species, or⁽³⁾;
 - ii. has dedicated lines or separation/flushing protocols to ensure that poultry rendered product is manufactured for export to Indonesia is not contaminated with porcine or ruminant material⁽³⁾;
 - b. has traceability of the animals through a reliable system;
 - c. keeps records on the animal species used for the production, noting the date of production on every consignment;
 - d. implements a quality and feed safety assurance system in accordance with Good Manufacturing Practices and Good Handling Practices.
4. The products have been subjected to a heat treatment which achieves thermal destruction of Clostridium perfringens.
5. The products must be subjected to routine post-production testing to demonstrate the absence of Salmonella and Clostridium. Those tests have been done at the following accredited laboratory, including the date and result of the test:

6. The products must be treated and processed based on the Government Regulation/Standards of the exporting country to ensure the safety of the products.
7. The rendered material has been processed either⁽³⁾:
 - a. with moist heat at a minimum temperature of 118°C for a minimum of 40 minutes; or

- b. with a continuous hydrolysing under at least 3,79 bar of pressure with steam at a minimum temperature of 122°C for a minimum of 15 minutes;
 - c. with an alternative rendering process that ensures that the internal temperature throughout the product reaches at least 74°C; or
 - d. using an alternative method that has been approved by the competent authority of the exporting country.
8. After the treatment, necessary precautions were taken to prevent contamination of the product with any potential source of pathogens.
 9. The products do not contain ruminant or porcine ingredients.
