- monthly down by 3.5%
- yearly down by 3.3%

In February 2026 according to the Bank of England, the Exchange Rate for New Zealand Dollars into Pound Sterling was \$2.26 per £. This was:

- monthly down by 2.3%
- yearly up by 2.4%

In February 2026, according to the Bank of England, the Exchange Rate for US Dollars into Euros was \$1.18 per €. This was:

Energy

Brent crude oil

In February 2026, the monthly average price of a barrel of brent crude oil was US\$70.80. This was:

- yearly down by 13.4%

Red diesel

In February 2026, a litre of red diesel cost 74.9 pence. This was:

- monthly down by 1.3%
- yearly down by 5.5%

Natural gas

In February 2026, the monthly average Title Transfer Facility (TTF) (Europe) price per megawatt hour of natural gas was €32.42. This was:

- monthly down by 2.5%
- yearly down by 35.4%

Correction: The data report for the UKAMMG meeting held on 10 February 2026 stated that the January 2026 monthly average Henry Hub price per megawatt hour of natural gas was €12.60. This was incorrect; the correct price was €20.93.

In February 2026, the monthly average Henry Hub (America) price per megawatt hour of natural gas was €10.45. This was:
