



# EMPLOYMENT TRIBUNALS

**Claimant:** Mr Christopher Amos

**Respondent:** Royal Mail Group Limited

## JUDGMENT

The claim is struck out.

## REASONS

1. By a letter dated 13 January 2026 the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to make representations or to request a hearing, as to why the claim should not be struck out because:-
  - the claimant had not complied with the Order of the Tribunal dated 31 July 2025 and
  - it has not been actively pursued.
2. This followed the respondent's application dated 19 December 2025.
3. The claimant has failed to make representations in writing, or has failed to make any sufficient representations, why this should not be done or to request a hearing.
4. The claim is therefore struck out as it is considered that it is not possible to thus have a fair trial on the dates when the case has been listed to be heard and it is proportionate in the overriding objective to do so.
5. The Hearing fixed for 16-19 February 2026 has been vacated and will not take place.
