I the undersigned certify that the goods described above meet the following requirements:

- (a) they have been inspected and found to be fit for human consumption;
- (b) they have been dressed, prepared and packed under hygienic conditions in accordance with regulations at present in force in the United Kingdom;
- (c) no outbreak of Newcastle disease has been confirmed within an area of 10km radius of the premises of origin during the past six months;
- (d) the entire consignment of poultry meat/product(s) came from birds which were kept in an establishment since they were hatched or for at least 21 days prior to slaughter, and there has been no evidence of highly pathogenic avian influenza (HPAI) in the establishment(s) during the 21 days prior to slaughter;
- (e) the entire consignment of poultry meat/product(s) came from birds which were slaughtered in an approved abattoir in which there had been no evidence of HPAI in the past 21 days, and were subject to ante-mortem and post-mortem inspections with favourable results;
- (f) The farms of origin of the birds, and the slaughter and processing and premises from which the meat originated, are not within any area subject to suspension by the Centre for Food Safety (CFS) of the Food and Environmental Hygiene Department, Hong Kong, due to outbreaks of notifiable avian disease;
- (g) based on the results of random sampling at slaughterhouses in the United Kingdom it can be considered that the poultry meat/product(s) does not contain residues exceeding the limits permitted within the United Kingdom, which do not occur naturally in the meat and which may have a hormonal or anti-hormonal effect;
