RE: **Potential particulates in certain Visipaque (Iodixanol) and Omnipaque (Iohexol) 100 ml polymer bottles**

Dear Healthcare Provider,

GE HealthCare in agreement with the Medicines and Healthcare Products Regulatory Agency would like to inform you that certain 100 ml bottles of Visipaque and Omnipaque (see attached for potentially impacted batch numbers) may have particles adhered to the polymer bottles.

The occurrence of these particulates is rare, and GE HealthCare has not received any customer complaints or reports of adverse events related to this issue. These batches are not being recalled in the UK and may continue to be used as directed.

With this letter we would like to draw your attention to the SmPC, section 6.6 'Special precautions for disposal', provided below for your convenience:

Like all parenteral products, Omnipaque/Visipaque should be inspected visually for particulate matter, discolouration and the integrity of the container prior to use.

Call for reporting

Please continue to report suspected adverse drug reactions (ADRs) to the MHRA through the Yellow Card scheme. You can report via the [Yellow Card website](#).

Please report:

- *all suspected ADRs that are serious or result in harm. Serious reactions are those that are fatal, life-threatening, disabling or incapacitating, those that cause a congenital abnormality or result in hospitalisation, and those that are considered medically significant for any other reason*
