IV. Health Information

I, the undersigned, being an Official Veterinarian of the United Kingdom hereby certify that:

(a) The animal(s) is certified as captive animal(s) as follows:

The animal(s) being presented for importation has been born and raised in captivity and, so far as can be determined, have not had exposure to wild animals.

(b) The animal(s) originate from a premises certified free from brucella abortus as follows:

The premises of origin have been free from any clinical, pathological or epidemiological evidence of brucellosis for the thirty-six (36) months immediately preceding the date of export to Canada and any quarantine related to the exportation.

(c) The animal(s) originate from a premises certified free from tuberculosis as follows:

The premises of origin has been free from any clinical, microbiological, pathological, or epidemiological evidence of tuberculosis (*Mycobacterium bovis*) for the thirty-six (36) months immediately preceding the date of export to Canada and any quarantine related to the exportation.

(d) The animal(s) originate from a premises certified free from pseudorabies (Aujeszky's Disease) as follows:

The premises of origin has been free from any clinical, pathological, or epidemiological evidence of pseudorabies (Aujeszky's Disease) for the thirty-six (36) months immediately preceding the date of export to Canada and any quarantine related to the exportation.

(e) The animal(s) originate from a premise certified free from rabies as follows:

The premises of origin has been free from any clinical, pathological or epidemiological evidence of rabies for the twenty-four (24) months immediately preceding the date of export to Canada and any quarantine related to the exportation.

(f) The animal(s) is certified for trypanosomiasis as follows:

There have not been any cases of trypanosomiasis diagnosed in the premises of origin in the twelve (12) months prior to certification, and each animal was subjected to an antibody enzyme linked immunosorbent assay (ELISA) or card agglutination test (CAT) for *T. evansi* in the 30 days prior to export with negative results. The test was performed in a laboratory approved by the competent veterinary authority in the country of origin.

- (g) The animal(s) is certified to have been vaccinated against rabies as follows:

The animal(s) being presented for importation have been vaccinated against rabies with an inactivated (killed) or recombinant vaccine approved for that purpose in the country of origin, manufactured according to World Organisation for Animal Health (WOAH) standards, and stored and administered according to manufacturer instructions. The animal(s) being presented for importation have been at least twelve (12) weeks of age at the time of vaccination and a period of at least twenty-eight (28) days must have elapsed between the date of vaccination and the date of export to Canada. The rabies vaccine is valid at the time of importation into Canada.

The animal(s) is certified to have been treated for ectoparasites and endoparasites as follows:

The animal(s) being presented for importation have been treated for ectoparasites and endoparasites with a broad-spectrum product(s) that includes coverage for cestodes, fleas and ticks and is approved for that purpose in the country of origin. The animal(s) have been treated more than four (4) days but not more than fourteen (14) days immediately prior to the date of export to Canada.

The animal(s) must be accompanied by documentation outlining any treatments or vaccinations that were completed during the six (6) months immediately preceding the date of export to Canada.

- (i) The animal(s) is certified as inspected by a veterinarian as follows:

The animal(s) being presented for importation have been inspected by a veterinary inspector designated for such purposes by the central veterinary service of the country of origin during the forty-eight (48) hour period immediately preceding export to Canada. The animal(s) did not demonstrate any clinical evidence of open/healing wounds, cysts or parasitic infection, and have been found to be healthy and free from any clinical evidence of contagious or infectious disease (including dermatological lesions) and, as far as can be determined, exposure thereto.

- (j) The animal(s) being presented for importation is identified by an acceptable electronic means.

(k) The animal(s) being presented for importation is certified to have been quarantined (that is, isolated from all other susceptible species) on a pre-embarkation quarantine premises, approved by a veterinary inspector of the central veterinary service of the country of origin or a veterinarian designated for such purposes by the central veterinary service of the country of origin, for a minimum of fourteen (14) days, or a longer period of time as necessary to complete the tests and/or treatments required to meet the requirements for import into Canada.

The animal(s) have remained free from any evidence of infectious and contagious disease during the quarantine period.

Under the direct supervision of the signing veterinary inspector of the central veterinary service of the country of origin or the signing veterinarian designated for such purposes by the central veterinary service of the country of origin:

The animals were transported without delay and without coming into contact with other susceptible animals, unless these animals had sanitary guarantees similar to those of the transported animals from the premises of origin to the pre-embarkation quarantine facility in vehicles or containers that were either new or had been cleaned and disinfected.

The approved pre-embarkation quarantine premises were thoroughly cleaned and disinfected prior to the entry of the animals. No animals of a lesser health status were introduced onto the approved pre-embarkation quarantine premises during the quarantine period.

No animal was moved from the pre-embarkation quarantine premises unless duly discharged by an inspector of the central veterinary service of the country of origin.

Any and all testing or treatment procedures have been conducted under the direct supervision of the signing veterinary inspector of the central veterinary service of the country of origin or the signing veterinarian designated for such purposes by the central veterinary service of the country of origin.

Care have been taken to ensure the sterility of all equipment and veterinary products associated with the conditions of the export certificate.

The animals were transported from the pre-embarkation quarantine premises directly to the port of embarkation in a conveyance, be it a vehicle, container, or other thing that was either new or had been cleaned and disinfected. During transit from the pre-embarkation quarantine premises to the port of embarkation and loading, the animals did not contact any animals or equipment used with animals of a lesser health status.

(m) The animal(s) is certified to be fit to be transported without undue suffering by reason of infirmity, illness, injury, fatigue or other cause during the expected journey.

- (n) I have received a written declaration from the owner/exporter that:
 - (i) the animal(s) will not come into contact with any animals, products or equipment of lesser health status during the entire transportation to the port of exportation;
 - (ii) when transport is by air, transportation of the animal(s) will be in accordance with the International Air Transport Association (IATA) live animals transport regulations approved by the Office of International des Epizooties (OIE);
 - (iii) for all forms of transport suitable arrangements have been made for the feeding, watering and care of the animal(s) during transportation as far as can be determined;
 - (iv) the animal(s) are not considered to be in an advanced stage of pregnancy, so are not expected to give birth during transportation;
 - (v) any young animals being shipped without a dam have been fully weaned prior to export.
 - (vi) The exporter is aware that the animal(s) for export to Canada must be shipped by the most direct and appropriate route from the point of export to the address of destination in Canada and that transshipment through another country requires written authorization from CFIA.
 - (vii) The animal(s) for export will be transported to the port /airport of departure in containers / vehicles previously cleansed and disinfected with an approved disinfectant and all conveyances (vehicles, containers, or other things) used to transport the qualifying animal(s) and their feed and water from the premises of origin until arrival at the Canadian port of entry have been cleaned and disinfected.
 - (viii) all conveyances (vehicles, containers, or other things) used to transport the qualifying animal(s) and other things such as feed from the premises of origin were cleaned and disinfected to my satisfaction prior to loading the animal(s) for export.
