Please could you provide a definition for the headings in the table, by which I mean the difference between GLD Fees and Charges and Disbursements.

Response

Fees and charges, primarily relates to the time we have spent on a case. Disbursement relates to those other costs directly incurred in supporting a case (e.g counsel).
