UK-Ukraine [100 Year Partnership first anniversary](#) celebrated achievements across defence & security, science & tech, economy & trade pillars [16 Jan]

FS hosted FM Sybiha for [UK-Ukraine Strategic Dialogue](#) where they discussed foreign and security policy priorities for the year ahead [13 Nov]

Supported [UNGA resolutions](#) condemning Russia's: deportation of children [3 Dec]; invasion [Feb 25, Feb 23, Mar 22]; attempted annexation of 4 Ukrainian regions [Oct 22]; & attacks on Ukraine's energy infrastructure [Jul 24]

At [UNSC](#), we hold Russia to account & reaffirm support for Ukraine
At OSCE, we call out Russia weekly & co-fund Support Programme for Ukraine. [5 fact-finding missions](#) reported on human rights abuses. Minister Doughty spoke at the Reinforced Permanent Council [24 Feb]
At IAEA, we support efforts towards nuclear safety in Ukraine. We supported the [5 March resolution](#) at the Board of Governors [5 Mar]

Military

£10.8bn total & [£3bn a year](#) for as long as it takes [Jul 24]
Two thirds of [£2.26bn](#) contribution to G7 ERA Loan disbursed [14 Apr]; The UK therefore provided [£4.5bn](#) total support in 2025 [Jan 25]

Delivering [120,000 drones](#) throughout 2026 [15 Apr]; over [£600m in air-defence support](#), including £150m via PURL [27 Mar]; [£600m](#) invested in air-defence capabilities in 2025 [17 Dec];
[Defence Industrial Support Treaty](#) [Jul 24]; expanded export finance cover incl. [£1.6bn for Thales](#) to supply 5,000 LMM missiles [10 Jul]; hundreds of [missiles delivered 5 months ahead](#) of schedule [10 Oct]; battlefield [technology agreement](#) boosts drone production [23 Jun]; Op INTERFLEX: >62,000 trained

UK-administered International Fund for Ukraine procures equipment: > [£2.6bn](#) pledged to date

Non-military

£5.3bn in non-military commitments since Feb 22. This includes: up to [£4.1bn](#) in fiscal support through World Bank loan guarantees up to £1.2bn in bilateral assistance. Up to [£283m](#) in 25/26 will fund humanitarian, energy, stabilisation, reform, recovery & reconstruction

Humanitarian

Committed [>£577m](#) assistance to Ukraine and the region [12 Sep]
At least £100m in 2025/2026, incl. [£10m](#) for Ukraine Humanitarian Fund & [£8m](#) for targeted winter assistance [3 Dec & 12 Nov]
£15.5 million for HALO Trust for mine action, incl. [£2.25m](#) for 2026. Over 1,030,783m² land cleared [June 22 to end Dec 25]

Recovery & Reconstruction

[War risk insurance](#) via MIGA & [EBRD](#) boosts inward investment
£3.5bn cover limit via UKEF for reconstruction projects supported reconstruction of [6 bridges](#) & delivery of [mine countermeasure vessels](#)
British International Investment, with EBRD has provided [€30m](#) for MHP to protect jobs & boost resilience in the agriculture sector [10 Jul]
[£25m](#) to strengthen Ukr social protection system & services [Feb 25]
[£50m](#) economic recovery programme helps SMEs [Jan & Feb 25]

Energy

Over £490m for energy security and resilience through grant, in-kind support and loan guarantees

£173m for the Ukraine Energy Support Fund including [£87m](#) for vital electricity network repairs and critical protection for gas & power infrastructure [24 Feb, 16 Jan, 12 Nov & 12 Sep]

[£1m](#) for Ukraine's Green Transition Office in 25/26 [12 Jul]

[£17m](#) to support UK and Ukrainian innovators through a second round of UK's Innovate Ukraine Green Energy Competition [Feb 25]

Sanctions

>3,200 individuals, entities & ships sanctioned under the Russia [sanctions regime](#), incl. >3,000 since Putin's full-scale invasion 595 vessels sanctioned including 568 oil tankers. Russian overall energy revenues est. to have decreased by 24% in 2025 vs 2024
UK, US and EU sanctions have denied Russia access to at least \$450bn since Feb 2022 - equiv. to ~2 years funding for the invasion
98.1% drop in UK goods imports from and 97.5% drop in exports to Russia Oct 24 - Sept 25 vs 2021

This Government has imposed sanctions against:
- [35 targets](#) involved in Russian drone production and human trafficking to support Russia's war machine
- [Nearly 300 targets](#), including energy revenues and military supply. Largest sanctions package since early 2022 [24 Feb]
- [24 targets across Russian oil, military and financial sectors](#). Incl. largest remaining unsanctioned oil companies [18 Dec]

War Crimes & Justice

The UK has provided £16.5m to support Ukraine's domestic war crimes investigations

Additional [£2.3m](#) to the International Criminal Court

>£2.8m to support return & reintegration of forcibly deported Ukr children - 600 identified by pilot tracing mechanism since Sep 25

Active in negotiations to establish [Special Tribunal for the Crime of Aggression](#) - Ukraine ratified bilateral agreement with CoE [15 Jul]
[Register of Damage](#) for Ukrainians to record war-related losses. UK chairs governing body & signed CoE Convention on the establishment of a [Claims Commission](#) to assess claims [16 Dec]

[Ukraine Permission Extension Scheme](#) opened Feb 25 & [extended](#) by 24mths [1 Sep]. 133,519 applications granted [as of 31 Dec]
