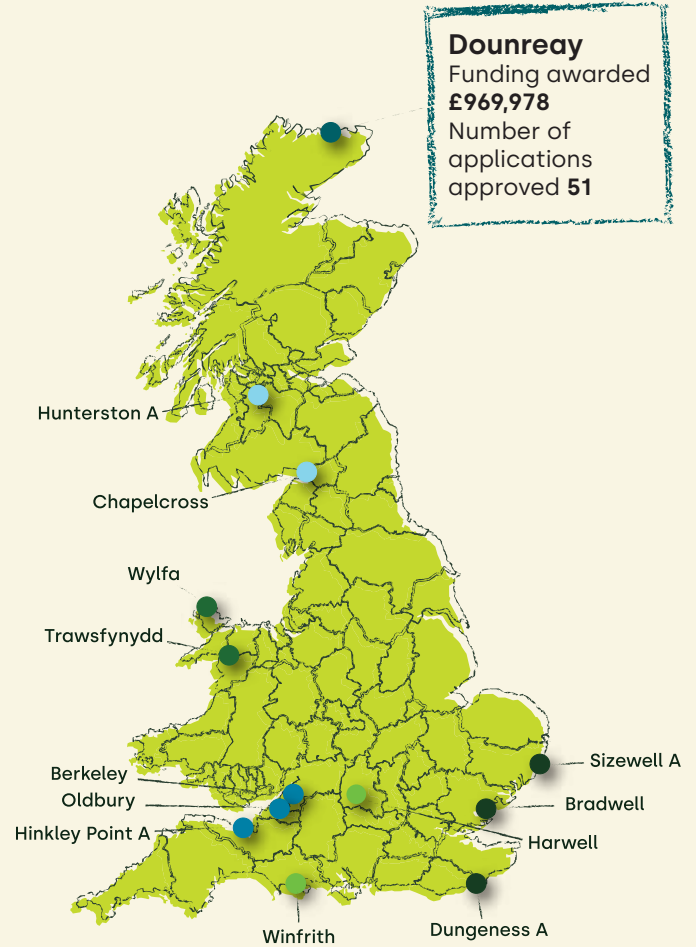

**NRS Sites** has funded **£1,009,743** for **88** organisations within our sites communities. Match funding of £14,323,704, equates to every £1 invested secured £14.18 from other sources. In addition, NDA funding of **£677,495**.

**NRS Dounreay** has funded **£969,978\*** for **51** community organisations. Securing match funding of £1,300,000 from other sources. In addition, NDA funding of **£252,777**.
