Thank you for your email of 12th September 2025 containing your request for information. The Government Legal Department ("GLD") have considered your request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 ("the Act", "FOIA")

Request

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, I request the following information:

1. The total costs incurred to date by the Government Legal Department in relation to the Afghanistan-linked contra mundum super-injunction, broken down by financial year.
2. A breakdown of those costs by category (e.g. payments to external counsel, court fees, internal staffing).
3. Any records identifying which government department(s) the costs have been billed to.

For clarity, I am not requesting privileged legal advice or ongoing litigation strategy, only aggregate costs and billing records.

Response

Pursuant to Section 1(1)(a), GLD confirms that it holds the information you have requested as set out below.

GLD only holds information on cases that we have been instructed on. Costs data includes time spent on the case, any disbursement incurred, and legal costs received and paid. Therefore, GLD only has information it has billed the client department in each case, as such please see table showing total billed costs. We are unable to break down costs any further than this without exceeding the costs limit in accordance with the Freedom of Information and Data Protection (Appropriate Limit and Fees) Regulations 2004.
