JUDGMENT

REASONS

1. The Tribunal wrote to the claimant on **12 January 2026** warning them that the Tribunal was considering striking out the claim. This was because it appeared to the Tribunal, applying Rule 38 of the Employment Tribunal Procedure Rules 2024, that
 - the claim had not been actively pursued.
2. The letter gave the claimant an opportunity to explain why the claim should not be struck out, or to request a hearing at which to do so. The claimant has not replied.
3. The claim is therefore struck out.
