## JUDGMENT

The claim for failure to provide pay slips pursuant to section 8 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 is struck out under rule 38(1)(c) of the Employment Procedure Rules 2024 (failing to comply with the rules and/or orders of the Tribunal) and rule 38(1)(d) (failure to pursue the claim).

## REASONS

The claimant failed to attend the final hearing today (as did the respondent), and has also failed to comply with any of the orders made by the Tribunal relating to preparation for today's hearing. Neither party answered the telephone when the Tribunal attempted to contact them. Neither party provided a reason for their non-attendance at the hearing. I also note that the respondent name is not a legal entity. The claimant may have intended to sue 'Lakeside Buckingham Stone Limited'. However, this company appears to be in liquidation, and so could not be sued without the permission of the court, which has not been granted.
