RULE 22 JUDGMENT

1. The respondent did not present a response to the claim. The claimant provided further information by correspondence to the Tribunal on 23 December 2025, upon which a determination could properly be made of the claim set out below pursuant to rule 22 of the Employment Tribunal Rules 2024.
2. The claim for breach of contract for the claimant's notice pay is well founded (Employment Tribunals Extension of Jurisdiction (England and Wales) Order 1994). The claimant's statutory notice period was seven weeks. The claimant was not paid for their notice period. The respondent must pay to the claimant £3696 net within 14 days.
