

THE OFFSHORE COMBUSTION INSTALLATIONS (POLLUTION PREVENTION AND CONTROL) REGULATIONS 2013 (as amended)

Regulations 8(1) and 8(2) Notice: Grant of Application for a Large Combustion Installation Permit

GOLAR-NOR (UK) LIMITED has made an application dated 5 January 2026 and updated 17 April 2026 under the Offshore Combustion Installation (Pollution Prevention and Control) Regulations 2013 (as amended). The Secretary of State has considered the application and in exercise of the powers available under the Offshore Combustion Installation (Pollution Prevention and Control) Regulations 2013 (as amended) hereby gives notice of its decision to grant a permit **PPC/123/0** to GOLAR-NOR (UK) LIMITED to undertake the operations as set out in the application, subject to the conditions specified in the schedules to the permit.

The grant of permit PPC/123/0 does not permit any extraction of oil or gas. Consent for extraction of oil and gas for the Rosebank field is subject to a separate application and decision process in accordance with the Offshore Oil and Gas Exploration, Production, Unloading and Storage (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2020 (the "2020 Regulations"). The grant of the permit does not affect the consideration of any further information provided for that process nor the fact that the decision to undertake work on the Rosebank field and the installation in the absence of a new decision on that application is at the risk of the developer of the field.

The reasons for the decision are that the Secretary of State is satisfied that the large combustion installation will be operated in compliance with regulations 7(2) and 7(3) of the Offshore Combustion Installation (Pollution Prevention and Control) Regulations 2013 (as amended). In particular, the Secretary of State is satisfied from considering the application and related documents that the large combustion installation will be operated in compliance with Directive 2010/75/EU. In reaching the decision the Secretary of State has taken into account relevant information provided to or obtained by the Secretary of State in relation to consideration of the Rosebank Environmental Statement ES/2022/001 under the 2020 Regulations, and the conclusion of the Secretary of State in 2022 in respect of that consideration.
