JUDGMENT

1. The claim was presented in the London South Employment Tribunal on 22 August 2025. The respondent has failed to present a valid response on time. The Employment Judge has decided that a determination can properly be made of the claim, or part of it, in accordance with rule 22 of the Rules of Procedure.
2. The respondent has made unauthorised deductions from the claimant's wages (£75 in May 2025 and £281.25 in June 2025) and must pay the claimant £356.25 gross.
3. The respondent must pay the claimant **£356.25** in total.
4. The claimant must account to HMRC for any sums owed by her in respect of any payment received by her pursuant to this judgment.
5. The claimant's claim for £2000 for stress caused by the tribunal process does not succeed and is dismissed. The tribunal does not have jurisdiction to award this sum as compensation for a claim for unlawful deduction of wages
