III. Health Information

I, the undersigned, certify that the animals described above meet the following requirements:

- a) On (date), being within 24 hours of export I examined the said animal(s)* and found it/them* to be free from clinical signs or symptoms of infectious or contagious disease, and fit to travel;
- b) It comes from a country where the following diseases are compulsorily notifiable (Foot and mouth disease - PPR - Blue tongue - Brucella - T.B)
- c) The establishment of origin is under veterinary supervision and complies with relevant biosecurity measures, with documented absence of notifiable infectious diseases for an appropriate period prior to export.
- d) The cervids undergo a supervised pre-export quarantine period of not less than 15 days in an quarantine facility, with daily clinical monitoring and veterinary oversight
- e) A written declaration has been received from the owner/exporter* stating that:

EITHER* (i) the said animal(s)* was/were* born and reared in the United Kingdom;

OR* (ii) the said animal(s)* was/were* legally imported into the United Kingdom and is/are* free from all post-import restrictions;
- f) The exported animal(s) has (have) been no clinical evidence of tuberculosis or brucellosis on the premises of origin during the past 42 days nor on any other premises where the animals have been resident during this period;

g) on _____ (date), being within 30 days of export, the said animal(s)* was/were* subjected to a single intradermal test for tuberculosis using both avian and bovine tuberculin with negative results in each case (negative means an increase in skin thickness of no more than 2mm and no oedema when read at 72 hours);

h) on _____ (date), being within 30 days of export, blood samples were taken from the said animal(s)* and sent to an official laboratory where they were submitted for testing for Brucella abortus by one of the following methods with negative results;

i) Either *a complement fixation test for brucella abortus (negative is a reaction of less than 8.3 icfu/ml),

ii) or *an ELISA test (Laboratory result reported as negative),

iii) or *a RBT test plus SAT test (RBT laboratory result reported negative and SAT equal or less than 30IUs);

i) the said animal(s)* is/are* not animal(s)* to be destroyed under an official scheme to eradicate contagious or infectious disease;

j) a written declaration has been received from the exporter/transporter* stating that:

i) the said animals(s) will be transported direct from the premises of origin via the port of shipment to the final destination at III (a) Transport should comply with international animal welfare standards, ensuring minimal transit time, appropriate stocking density and in vehicles cleansed and disinfected beforehand with DEFRA approved disinfectant and without coming into contact with animals other than those similarly certified:

ii) The said animal(s) has been resident on the holding of origin for at least 20 days immediately prior to export or since birth:

iii) Any standstill period as a result of the movement of animals onto the holding of origin, imposed by the Disease Control (England) Order 2003 (as amended) or equivalent legislation in Wales and Scotland has been complied with.
