REQUEST FOR INFORMATION: Poultry Registration Figures

Thank you for your request for information of 7th December about Poultry Registration Figures. APHA have handled your request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

Your information request and our response are set out below.

“I would like to know how many poultry flocks Under 50 birds are registered in England.”

APHA can confirm that there are 160,111 Poultry Livestock Units registered in England with less than 50 birds.

Please note that APHA use the following species for ‘poultry’; chicken, duck, goose, guinea fowl, ostrich, partridge, pheasant, quail, emu, turkey, rhea and pigeon.

Information disclosed in response to this FOI request is releasable to the public. In keeping with the spirit and effect of the FOIA and the government’s Transparency Agenda, this letter and the information disclosed to you may be placed on GOV.UK, together with any related information that will provide a key to its wider context.
