## The Crisis and Resilience Fund can provide:



**Crisis payments**



**Housing payments**



**Support in emergencies**



You may be able to get help from your local council if you are on a low income and having problems with money. For example, you cannot afford things you need.

**It can help if you're finding it hard to pay for things like:**



**Energy and water bills**



**Food**



**Housing costs – if you owe rent, you can get help**



**Things you need for the home, like furniture or appliances**



# Who can get help



**You can get help if you are on a low income and can't pay for the things you need**



**If you do get benefits, they won't be affected**



**You can ask for support to help you apply**



# Help near you

**Your council will decide how it gives help.**

Each council may have different rules about:



**Who can apply for help**



**How you apply**



**Who can get money**



You can also talk to local charities or community groups who may know what support is available in your local area.
