## JUDGMENT

1. The claim is struck out pursuant to Rule 38 on the grounds that it has no reasonable prospect of success as:
  - a. The Tribunal does not have jurisdiction to hear the claims – the claims were for quantum meruit for work done, although presented as unauthorised deductions of wages;
  - b. The claim was presented out of time
  - c. The claim was an abuse of process, the same claim having been presented in claim 6012236/2025 which was struck out in November 2025.
