I, the undersigned, certify that the birds described above meet the following requirements:

- a) on _____ (date), being within 5 days of the intended date of export, I inspected the said birds and found them to be free from clinical signs of infectious or contagious disease, free from injuries, and fit to travel;
- b) during the 180 days immediately preceding the date of issue of this health certificate the birds have not been kept at any premises, farm, or other establishment in II b) where there was serological or virological evidence of the presence of H5 or H7 avian influenza (fowl plague);
- c) all birds have been kept in government approved quarantine facilities for **28 days** prior to the export, and have all remained clinically normal during this period;
- d) on _____ (date), during pre-export isolation and within 14 days prior to export, all birds, or a sample of birds (at a sample rate of not less than ___ birds), were subject to at least one of the following diagnostic tests for H5 and H7 avian influenza virus conducted in accordance with the WOAHA Manual of Diagnostic Tests and Vaccines for Terrestrial Animals with negative results in each case:

(i)* Virology tests using oropharyngeal swabs, cloacal swabs or fresh faecal specimens;

(ii)* RT-PCR tests using oropharyngeal swabs;

OR

(iii)* Serology tests using Haemagglutination Inhibition Tests and H5 and H7 avian influenza antigens (if sufficient blood can be obtained);

e) **EITHER**

(i)* the birds have not been within 100 kilometres of any reported case of West Nile virus during the past 180 days;

OR

(ii)* the quarantine facility was mosquito proof and all birds, or a sample of birds (at a sample rate of not less than ___ birds) have been serologically tested for West Nile virus with a negative result within 14 days prior to export to Hong Kong;

f) **For birds of the Psittaciformes order ONLY**

No clinical sign of avian Chlamydiosis, Pacheco's Disease and Psittacine Proventricular Dilatation Syndrome (PPDS) was shown on the day of examination within **5 days** prior to export.
