

Dear Lyle Wilton,

In connection with the Comprehensive Economic and Trade Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the Republic of India ("the Agreement"), signed on 24 July 2025, I have the honour to acknowledge receipt of your letter of this date, which reads as follows:

In connection with the Comprehensive Economic and Trade Agreement between the Government of the Republic of India and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland ("the Agreement"), signed at Buckinghamshire on 24 July 2025, I have the honour to confirm the following understanding reached between the Government of the Republic of India ("India") and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland ("the United Kingdom") (together "the Participants") following the conclusion of the consultations referred to in paragraph 3 of the letter on Geographical Indications dated 24 July 2025 ("India's IP Side Letter 1") with regard to Section D (Geographical Indications) of Chapter 13 (Intellectual Property Rights):

Geographical Indications to be listed in the Annex to India's IP Side Letter 1

- 1. The Participants have decided on the geographical indications to be listed in the Annex to India's IP Side Letter 1. Those geographical indications are set out in the Annex to this letter.*
- 2. The content of the Annex to this letter will constitute the content of the Annex to India's IP Side Letter 1.*
- 3. The Participants acknowledge that, for the purposes of Article 13.36 (Initial Geographical Indications Submitted for Protection) of the Agreement, the content of the Annex to this letter is a list, drawn up by the Participants prior to entry into force of the Agreement, of geographical indications that may be submitted for protection under Section D (Geographical Indications) of Chapter 13 (Intellectual Property Rights) of the Agreement.*

Final provisions

- 4. For the avoidance of doubt, this letter does not give rise to legally binding obligations.*
- 5. The Participants will treat the content of the Annex to this letter in confidence until entry into force of the Agreement.*

I have the honour to propose that this letter and your letter in reply, confirming that your Government shares this understanding, will constitute an understanding between our two Governments, which will enter into effect on the date of your reply.
