JUDGMENT

BY CONSENT:

1. The claimant's claim for unauthorised deductions from wages succeeds. The respondent shall pay the claimant the sum of £980, less any appropriate deductions for tax and national insurance contributions.
2. The claimant's whistleblowing claim is dismissed upon withdrawal by the claimant.
