JUDGMENT

The claim is struck out.

REASONS

1. The Tribunal wrote to the claimant on 27 March 2026 warning them that the Tribunal was considering striking out the claim. This was because it appeared to the Tribunal, applying Rule 38 of the Employment Tribunal Procedure Rules 2024, that
 - The claimant had not complied with the Order of the Tribunal dated 27 March 2026 and 8 April 2026.
 - The claim had not been actively pursued.
 - The Tribunal does not have jurisdiction to hear the claim as detailed in the Tribunal's correspondence of 27 March 2026.
2. The letter gave the claimant an opportunity to explain why the claim should not be struck out, or to request a hearing at which to do so. The claimant has not replied.
3. I am satisfied that the grounds for striking out the claim under Rule 38 apply, and that it would be in accordance with the overriding objective in Rule 3 to strike out the claim. This is because it is proportionate and saves expense
4. The claim is therefore struck out.
