JUDGMENT

The claim is struck out.

REASONS

1. The Tribunal wrote to the claimant on **30th March 2026** warning them that the Tribunal was considering striking out the claim. This was because it appeared to the Tribunal, applying Rule 38 of the Employment Tribunal Procedure Rules 2024, that:
 - The Claimant had not complied with the Order of the Tribunal dated **15th January 2026**; and
 - The claim had not been actively pursued.
2. The letter gave the Claimant an opportunity to explain why the claim should not be struck out, or to request a hearing at which to do so. The Claimant has not replied.
3. I am satisfied that the grounds for striking out the claim under Rule 38 apply, and that it would be in accordance with the overriding objective in Rule 3 to strike out the claim.
4. The claim is therefore struck out.
