**The Contracts for Difference (Electricity Supplier Obligations)
(Amendment) Regulations 2026**

Laid before Parliament

Coming into force

The Secretary of State makes these Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by section 27(2)(b) of the Energy Prices Act 2022(a).

Citation, commencement and extent

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Contracts for Difference (Electricity Supplier Obligations) (Amendment) Regulations 2026 and come into force on [XXX].

(2) These Regulations extend to England and Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland.

Amendment of the Contracts for Difference (Electricity Supplier Obligations) Regulations 2014

2. The Contracts for Difference (Electricity Supplier Obligations) Regulations 2014 are amended as follows.

Amendment to regulation 2 (interpretation)

3. In regulation 2, in the definition of “SoS funds”, omit “(under section 154(2)(b) of the Act)”.

Amendment to regulation 5 (CFD quarterly contribution)

4. In regulation 5, for the definition of “SoS repayment” substitute—

“SoS repayment is the total amount of SoS funds that the CFD counterparty was required to repay during that period;”.

Amendment to regulation 7 (estimated cost, income and electricity supply)

5. In regulation 7—

(a) in paragraph (1)—

(i) after “sum of” omit “any SoS repayment and”;

- (ii) after “estimates of” insert “any SoS repayment and”;
- (b) in paragraph (2), before sub-paragraph (a) insert—
 - “(za) the terms on which any SoS funds have been or are expected to be provided to the CFD counterparty;”.
