



It is illegal to harass people

In the UK, everyone has the right to feel safe in public. You must never:

- make sexual comments to strangers, even as a compliment
- approach someone repeatedly if they are not interested
- follow someone or block their path



If you harass someone in public, you could be arrested by the police. This could affect your asylum support and your asylum claim.



If you see or experience harassment, you can report it to the police. Reporting will not negatively affect your asylum claim.
