



Grey gurnard

(*Eutrigla gurnardus*)

Identifying features

Body

- Large thorny scales on lateral line.

Fins

- Black mark on first, smaller dorsal.
- Small pectoral fins.

Colour

- Grey eyes.
- Grey-brown body with red tinge on the back and sides.
- Small white spots on the sides.

Quota or non-quota

Non-quota.



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Red gurnard

(*Chelidonichthys cuculus*)

Identifying features

Body

- Sharp beak.

Fins

- 2-3 enlarged rays on red pectorals.

Colour

- Yellow eyes.
- Red body with pink-silver mottling.

Quota or non-quota

Non-quota.



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Tub gurnard

(*Chelidonichthys lucerna*)

Identifying features

Body

- Smooth scales on lateral line.
- Stocky body shape.

Fins

- Large pectoral fins with bright blue spots and blue edges.

Colour

- Brown to reddish-brown body.

Quota or non-quota

Non-quota.



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
