Form requesting information for movement from the Bluetongue Restriction Zone to Scotland or Wales to live

Requests to move animals to live from the Bluetongue Temporary Control Zone to the free area of Scotland, require either a valid pre-movement test or completed vaccination course with the Bultavo-3 vaccine for cattle. For cattle that meet the vaccination requirements for movement, the licence will only be valid from 21 days after the second vaccine dose. All requests for movement of sheep require them to be pre-movement tested, even if they are vaccinated. Pre-movement testing should take place at least 7 days after any Bluetongue vaccination has been administered.
