

DECLARATION OF SPECIAL MEASURES: TURKEY

THE TRADE IN ANIMALS AND RELATED PRODUCTS (WALES) REGULATIONS 2011 (S.I. 2011/2379 (W. 252))

The Welsh Ministers have reasonable grounds for suspecting the existence of *Tropilaelaps* mite (*Tropilaelaps spp.*) in Turkey, such that certain animals and products originating in or dispatched from Turkey are liable to pose risk to human or animal health.

In exercise of the powers conferred by regulation 29(1) of the Trade in Animals and Related Products (Wales) Regulations 2011¹, the Welsh Ministers declare the following special measures to be necessary in Wales in order to contain the risk to human or animal health:

Suspension of entry of certain products into Wales

1. Entry into Wales is suspended in respect of the following animals and products originating in or dispatched from Turkey:
 - a. honeybees;
 - b. unprocessed apiculture by-products;
 - c. used beekeeping equipment;
 - d. apiculture products in honeycomb intended for human consumption.
2. The restriction in paragraph 1(b) does not apply to apiculture by-products which are:
 - a. intermediate products;
 - b. research and diagnostic samples; or
 - c. trade samples.

Interpretation

3. In this Declaration:

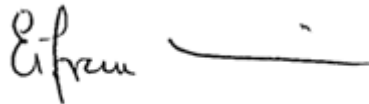

- a. “apiary” means an establishment which keeps honeybees;
- b. “beehive” means a container used for keeping honeybees;
- c. “intermediate product”, “research and diagnostic samples” and “trade samples” have the same meanings as in Annex 1 to assimilated Commission Regulation (EU) No 142/2011;
- d. “unprocessed apiculture by-products” means honey, beeswax, royal jelly, propolis or pollen not intended for human consumption as defined in point 10 of Annex I to assimilated Commission Regulation (EU) No 142/2011 which have not undergone any processing procedure as referred to in Chapter II, Section 1, Table 2, Row 10 of the fourth column (*import and transit conditions*), of Annex XIV to that Regulation;
- e. “used beekeeping equipment” means used:
 - i. beehives;
 - ii. parts of beehives; and
 - iii. utensils used in an apiary.

Coming into force and duration of the special measures

4. The special measures in this Declaration apply from the beginning of the day after the day on which this Declaration is made until this Declaration is revoked or amended by further declaration.
