

Permitting decisions- Surrender

We have decided to accept the surrender of the permit for **Manor Farm** operated by **Harvey Farms (Winterbourne) Limited**.

The permit number is **EPR/LP3539UR/S008**

The decision was issued on **02/09/26**.

We are satisfied that the necessary measures have been taken to avoid any pollution risk and to return the site to a satisfactory state. We consider in reaching this decision that we have taken into account all relevant considerations and legal requirements.

Key issues of the decision

- The installation was a pig farm intensive farming activity.
- The pig farm stopped operating above relevant EPR scheduled activities for sows and production pigs (>30kg) in March 2024.
- The installation has had last pigs removed from the installation in June 2026.
- The permit is being surrendered in full, with no intention to place any pigs whatsoever within installation boundary in the future as confirmed by the Operator.
- The installation land has had planning approved in 2025 for light industrial buildings and storage facilities and building has already started.

- The site was decommissioned by mid-August 2026.
- Our site officer visited the site 26th August 2026.
- The local Environment Officer has confirmed the site is considered low risk and is satisfied that the condition of the installation is acceptable to be surrendered.

Decision considerations

Confidential information

A claim for commercial or industrial confidentiality has not been made.

The decision was taken in accordance with our guidance on confidentiality.

Identifying confidential information

We have not identified information provided as part of the application that we consider to be confidential.

Pollution risk

We are satisfied that the necessary measures have been taken to avoid a pollution risk resulting from the operation of the regulated facility.

Satisfactory state

We are satisfied that the necessary measures have been taken to return the site of the regulated facility to a satisfactory state, having regard to the state of the site before the facility was put into operation.

Growth duty

We have considered our duty to have regard to the desirability of promoting economic growth set out in section 108(1) of the Deregulation Act 2015 and the guidance issued under section 110 of that Act in deciding whether to accept this permit surrender.
