



# EMPLOYMENT TRIBUNALS

**Claimant:** Mr A Long

**Respondent:** Total Home Delivery Ltd

## RULE 22 JUDGMENT

1. The claim for unauthorised deductions from wages (Employment Rights Act 1996 section 13) is well founded. The respondent must pay to the claimant within 14 days:
  - a. Unpaid wages: £2849.71 (gross)
  - b. Holiday pay: £1425.60 (gross)
  - c. £319.25 (gross) deducted ostensibly for pension contributions but for which the respondent made no contributions to the claimant's pension
2. The claim for breach of contract for the claimant's notice pay is well founded (Employment Tribunals Extension of Jurisdiction (England and Wales) Order 1994). The claimant's statutory notice period was 12 weeks. The claimant was not paid for their notice period. The respondent must pay to the claimant £6941 (net) within 14 days (£7716 (net) less £775 earnings in mitigation).
