II.4 Animal transport (labelling)

II.4.1 the consignment is identified by a legible label on the exterior of the transport container, or an entry in the ship's manifest when transported by well boat, which clearly links the consignment to this animal health certificate with the relevant information referred to in boxes I.2 and 1.7 to I.12, and with the following statement:
