PRIVATE PRELIMINARY HEARING

JUDGMENT UNDER RULE 47

1. All the claimant's claims are dismissed.
2. The final hearing dates on 5 October to 16 October 2026 are vacated.

REASONS

1. The claimant failed to attend today's preliminary hearing.
2. The claimant failed to attend the hearing on 28 August 2026.

3. The claimant did not respond to the efforts made today by the Tribunal's administration to contact her.
4. The claimant was notified of today's hearing on 28 August 2026 having failed to attend the hearing on that date.
5. The claimant provided no indication of or explanation for her non-attendance at today's hearing.
6. The Tribunal's resources are limited, and proportionality requires that each case gets its fair share (and no more) of Tribunal time.
7. The claimant has failed to engage with the Tribunal in the pursuit of her own claim.
8. The claimant has failed to comply with earlier directions, including the exchange of witness statements.
9. There is no indication that the claimant is pursuing his claim.
