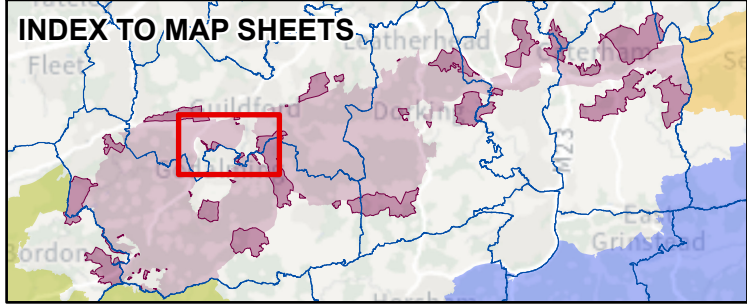
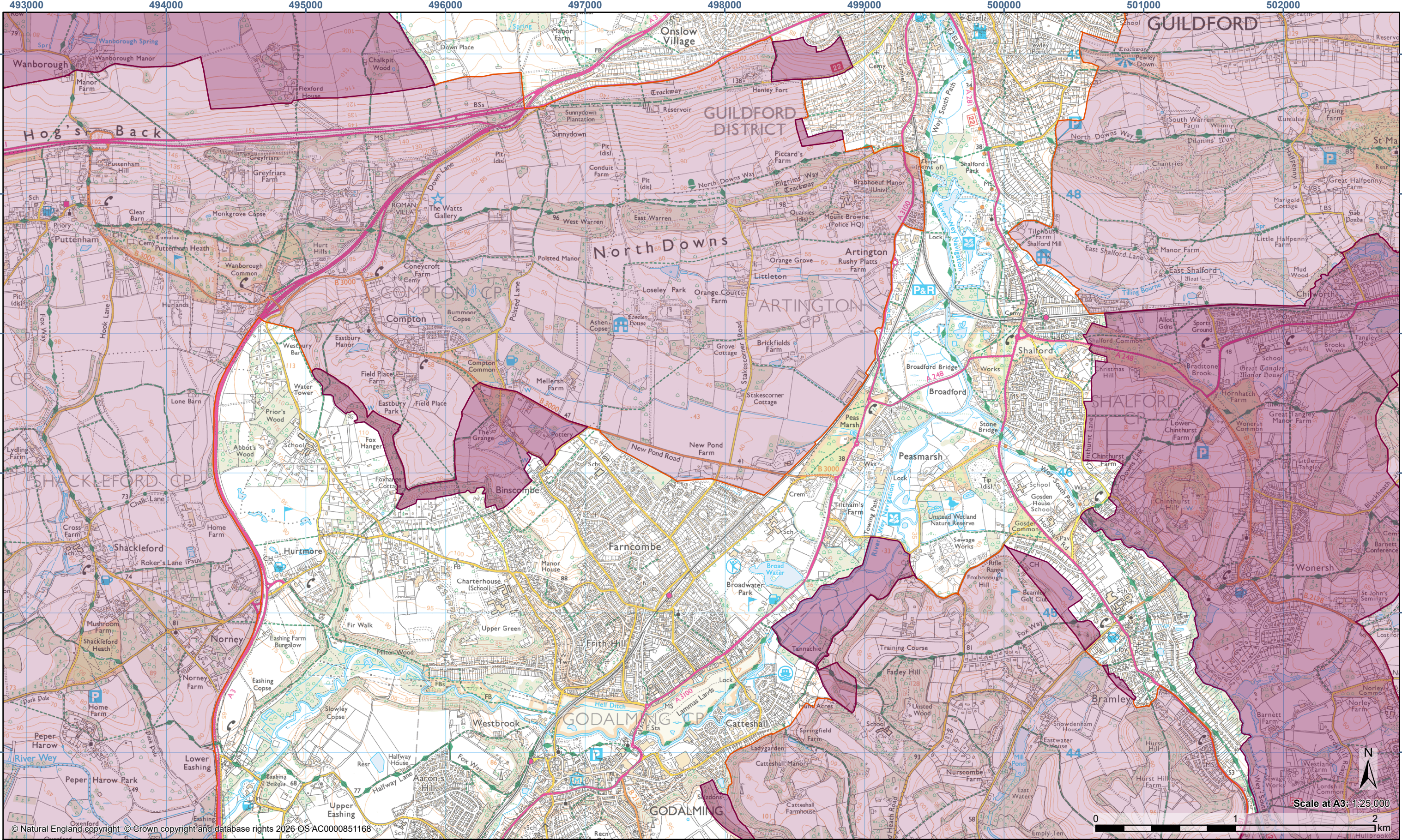




Boundary Variation
Boundary Variation - Surrey Hills

Existing Designated Landscape
Surrey Hills National Landscape (AONB)

The existing area of Surrey Hills AONB is shown edged in red and shaded light purple. The extension areas are shown edged in dark purple and shaded purple.

2. Where proposed Surrey Hills AONB extension areas adjoin any existing AONB or National Park, the boundaries will be contiguous, with no overlaps or gaps between designations.
