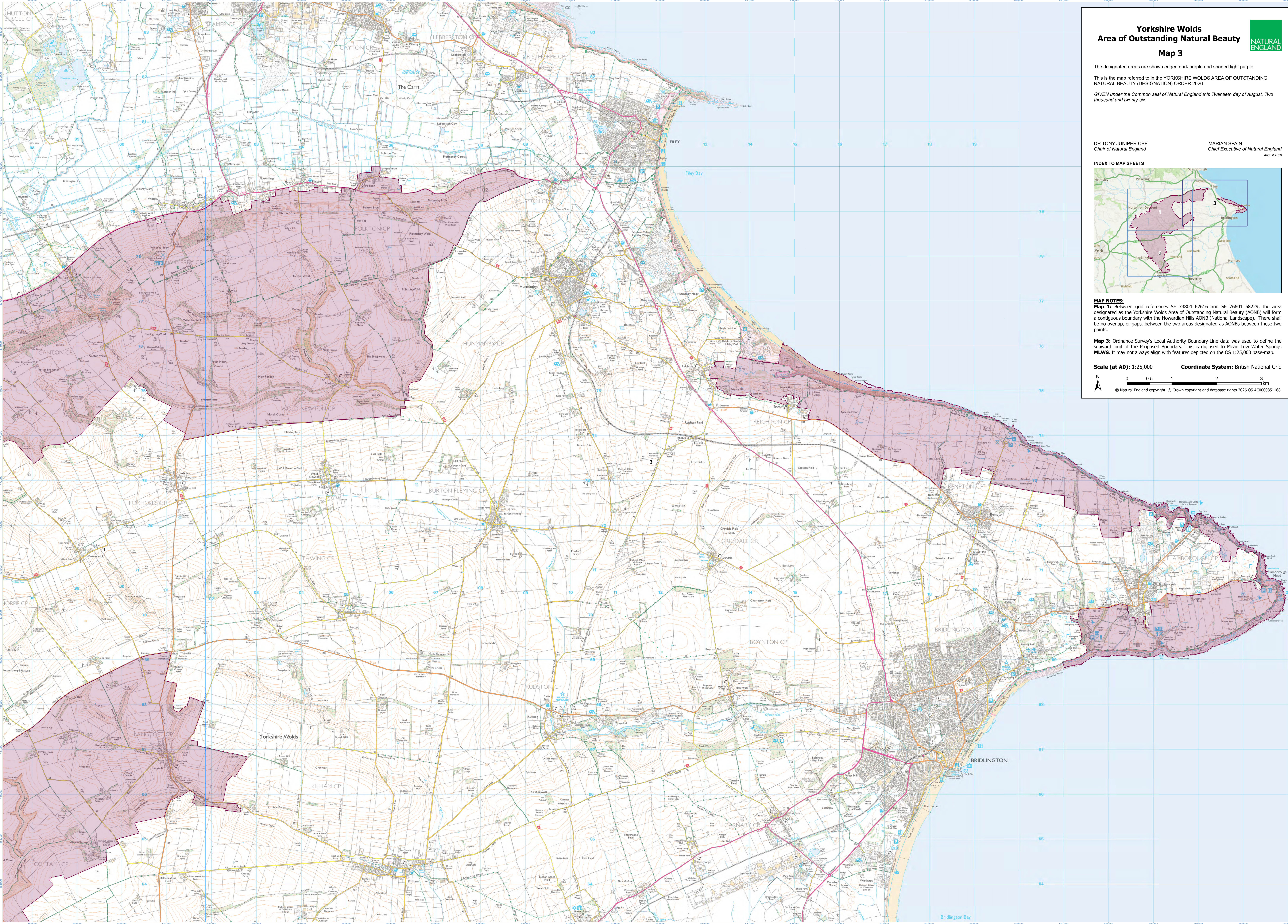

The designated areas are shown edged dark purple and shaded light purple.

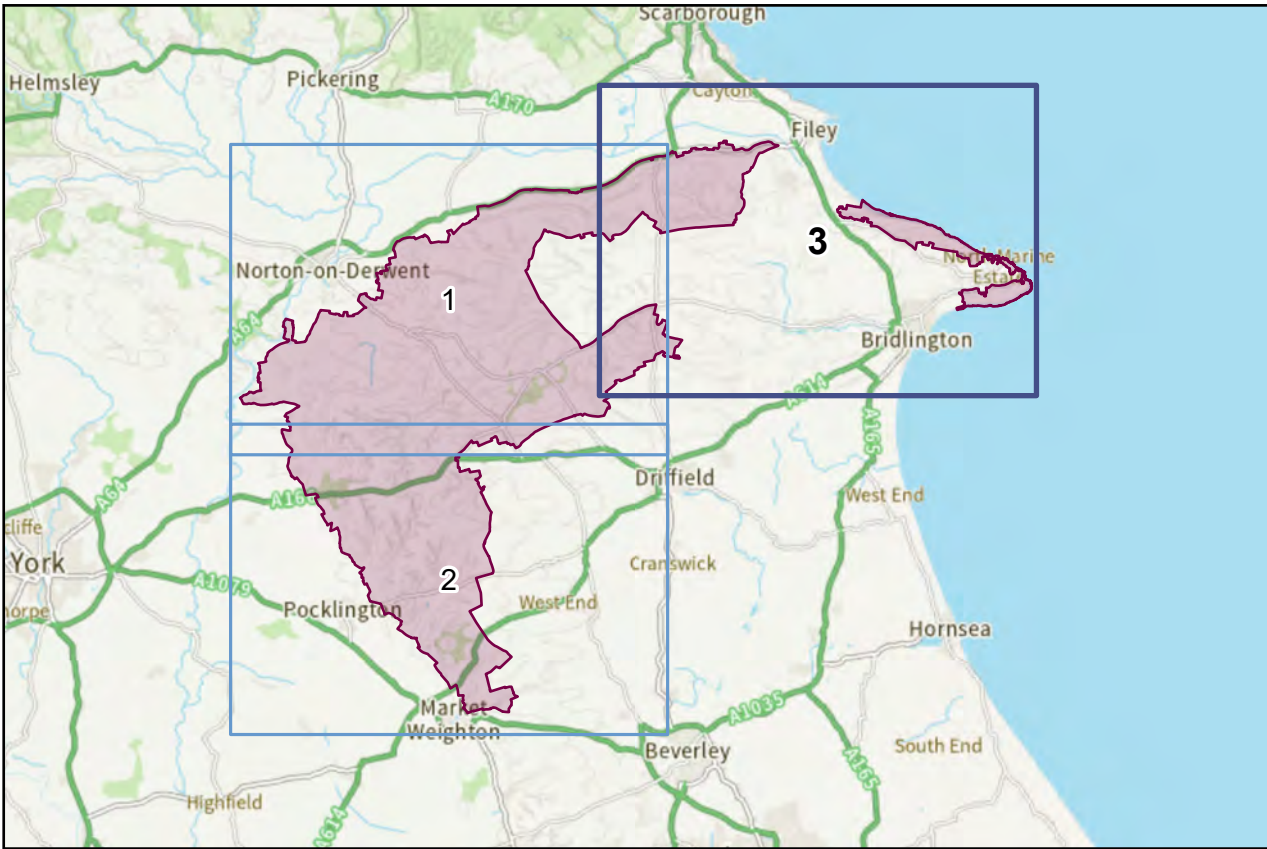

MAP NOTES:

Map 1: Between grid references SE 73804 62616 and SE 76601 68229, the area designated as the Yorkshire Wolds Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty (AONB) will form a contiguous boundary with the Howardian Hills AONB (National Landscape). There shall be no overlap, or gaps, between the two areas designated as AONBs between these two points.

Map 3: Ordnance Survey's Local Authority Boundary-Line data was used to define the seaward limit of the Proposed Boundary. This is digitised to Mean Low Water Springs (MLWS). It may not always align with features depicted on the OS 1:25,000 base-map.
