JUDGMENT

The claim is struck out.

REASONS

1. The Tribunal wrote to the claimant on 28 May 2026 warning them that the Tribunal was considering striking out the claim. This was because it appeared to the Tribunal, applying Rule 38 of the Employment Tribunal Procedure Rules 2024, that:
 - The claimant had not complied with the Order of the Tribunal dated 10 April 2025.
 - The claim had not been actively pursued.
2. The letter gave the claimant an opportunity to explain why the claim should not be struck out, or to request a hearing at which to do so.
3. I am satisfied that the grounds for striking out the claim under Rule 38 apply, and that it would be in accordance with the overriding objective in Rule 3 to strike out the claim. This is because the claimant has failed to respond, has not provided further details of her claims as previously directed, and has not complied with the Employment Judge Brewer's Order requiring an explanation for her non-attendance at the Case Management Hearing on 19 February 2026.
4. The claim is therefore struck out.
5. **The hearing on 28-30 September 2026 will not take place.**
